History of the Guild.

Volume I. This volume was published in July 1983. It was written by the late Past Master Colin Dyer and traces the story of the formation of the Guild through its first 75 years.

Volume II. Covering the years from the 75th Anniversary in 1983 to the completion of the Centenary Year 2008/2009, this superbly illustrated book, written by the late Past Master Raymond Holl, focuses on the people and organizations that have been and remain an integral part of the Guild's activities.

Brooches, Cufflinks, Tie Tacks Stickpins and Dress Studs.

The Gemset brooches features a pendant fitting to enable it to be worn with a neck chain. A hand-made 18ct gold brooch set with rubies and diamonds is also available by special order.

The Rhodium plated brooch has the Guild crest in red and white enamel, a detachable safety chain and is supplied in a gift box.

The Centenary Pearl & Enamel Brooch was commissioned to compliment the jewel worn by HRH The Princess Royal, our Centenary Master. Finished in Silver Gilt the enamelled Guild crest is surrounded by 32 radiating pearls.

The traditional cufflinks comprise a shield showing the Guild's crest in enamel and have a toggle fitting. They are available in either gilt metal or silver gilt.

The new design cufflinks comprise the Guild's coat of arms engraved on an oval plate, with enamel inlay. The gilt metal cufflinks have a toggle fitting; the silver gilt cufflinks are double ovals linked by a chain.

The tie tack has a secure clutch fitting with chain and bar to hold the tie neatly and handsomely in place.

The stickpin is a wonderfully versatile accessory. Not only can it be worn by ladies but also it is an ideal alternative to a tie tack for gentlemen.

The dress shirt studs match the traditional design of the Guild's cuff-links with the shield of the Guild's Arms in red and white enamel. The face of the studs are approx 11mm in height and width and the backs are round (approx 10mm in diameter). These studs are sold as a set of 4 and are presented in a gift box.

Silk Ties.

For formal occasions there is a choice of Wine or Blue, with the coat of arms in heraldic colours in a central position and multiple representations of the coat of arms in shadow weave throughout the tie.

For less formal occasions the Country Tie is designed in red, gold and white diagonal stripes, with the coat of arms woven in at the bottom.

Bow Ties are currently available in the Country Tie fabric in a ready tied or self-tying option.

Polyester Ties.

Made of good quality polyester fabric these ties embody a single embroidered coat of arms of the Guild in heraldic colours and are available in Black, Wine or Maroon.

Pewter Scarf Ring

This bespoke design scarf ring has been handmade in the UK by Glover & Smith using traditional methods from the finest Lead-Free Pewter. With a diameter of 7cm they feature the Guild crest in the centre and are supplied in a gift box with a silver organza bag.

Guild Crested Velvet Slippers

These stylish velvet slippers feature the Guild Crest in Gold & Silver Wire and Coloured threads. Beautifully lined in satin quilt, with a leather sole and heel, they are hand-embroidered and handmade to order in the UK.

Linen Napkins.

These are superb quality white linen napkins (56 x 56 cm approx.) with the Guild's coat of arms embroidered in full colour on one corner. They can be bought singly or in packs of 4.

Christmas Cards.

These are white cards with the Guild's coat of arms printed in colour in the centre on the front, and with a simple festive message on the inside. The cards are supplied with matching envelopes.

Blazer Badges.

These high-quality badges, woven in gilt wire on a black background, show the Guild's armorial bearings.

Handbag Hooks.

These are designed to rest on a dinner or bar table and hold a lady's handbag. They display the Guild's coat of arms in coloured enamel and are supplied with a pouch. Length approx. 13 cm.

Halcyon Days Boxes.

Specially designed to commemorate the Guild's centenary, each box portrays the Guild's coat of arms on the lid; the inside of the lid carries a commemorative inscription and the base of the box is plain red. The boxes were made in a limited edition of 300, with each box individually numbered on the base.

Wall Plaques.

These are in the form of a heraldic shield on a wood base.
